AFFIDAVIT

I, the undersigned,

CHRISTINE ANDERSON

Do hereby make oath and state that:

- I am a major female, previously in the employment of the South African National Defence Force ("SANDF"). I am residing at 1834 Brandberg Street Hentiesbaai Namibia.
- 2. The facts contained herein fall within my personal knowledge and are both true and correct.
- 3. I attest the purpose of this affidavit.
- I attest to this affidavit in response to a Notice in terms of Rule 3.3 that was delivered to my attorneys on or about 21 June 2019.

BACKGROUND

 I submitted an affidavit for a Board of Inquiry under convening order number 01/2013 dated 03 May 2013. I attach hereto the affidavit with annexures thereto as annexure "CA1". This affidavit with annexures thereto, (annexure "CA1")

is in response to some of the allegations as set out in the Notice in terms of Rule 3.3, mentioned hereinabove.

- 6. In this affidavit I will firstly respond to the paragraphs in the said notice in terms of Rule 3.3 and I will firstly respond to the paragraphs in the JCPS Cluster report and secondly respond to the witness statements which were downloaded from the website.
- 7. Should I be requested by the Chairperson to appear before the Commission I am willing to do so on condition that all the documents, records and transcripts are provided to me timeously to prepare for such an appearance.

JCPS CLUSTER REPORT

8. AD Paragraph 2.1.15 thereto:

I stand with what I have stated in the affidavit annexure "CA1".

9. AD Paragraph 2.1.16 thereto:

I do not have knowledge of these statements as I was not a party to this conversation.

10. AD Paragraph 2.1.17 thereto:

- 10.1 I admit I returned a call to Maj Ntshisi. I repeat what I have stated in the affidavit annexure "CA1". I confirm that Ministers have been allowed to land at Waterkloof Airforce Base should DIRCO approve the landing.
- 10.2 I was on more than one occasion informed by Mr Koloane that Number1, the President, knew about this request for the Indian Delegation to land at Airforce Base Waterkloof.

11. AD Paragraph 2.1.18 thereof:

I have no comment on this paragraph in that I was not a party to this conversation.

12. AD Paragraph 3.1 thereto:

I deny that a meeting took place on 24 April 2013. A meeting however did take place on 22 April 2013 as appear from paragraphs 9.9 and 9.10 of annexure "CA1" attached hereto.

13. AD Paragraph 3.2 thereto:

- 13.1 I did agree with Col Frederickson and Col Visser that the flight should never have landed. I only came to this conclusion after the flight has landed and I realised that there were no Ministers on board the flight.
- 13.2 I did not facilitate the processing of the passports. I may have assisted the representative of the visiting party Mr Ashook Twala (I am not certain of his surname) to hand the passports to the immigration officer that was present at the Base. There is nothing sinister in this. It is normal procedure that the passports are collected from the visiting party and handed to the immigration officer present. It is then the prerogative of the immigration personnel to decide how to handle the people entering the Republic of South Africa.

14.AD Paragraph 4 thereto:

14.1 I deny the findings in paragraph 4. I did not share a common purpose with Mr. Koloane. Mr. Koloane informed me that the President knew about the visit and I returned a telephone call of Maj Ntishisi and informed him nothing more that what was told to me by Mr. Koloane. I am still of the opinion that Ministers can be accommodated at Waterkloof



Airforce Base and it has happened in the past whilst I performed this function.

14.2 I deny that I inverted command and control and unduly influenced Maj Ntishisi. I deny all the findings that were made against me as it appears from paragraph 4 in the Cluster Report. It is clear from the testimony of Maj Ntishisi that I returned his call. I relayed to him what was told to me by Mr. Koloane and I did not try to influence Maj. Ntishisi at all.

15. Me TN Sindane:

- 15.1 I did not refuse to speak to the investigation team.
- 15.2 I did receive a telephone call from a Warrant Officer at Waterkloof Airforce Base asking me to come and see Brig Gen Mchetwa (OCVIP).

 The Warrant Officer did not say anything about an investigation. The Warrant Officer phoned me whilst I was on my way to our farm in Randfontein and no one gave a warning about the possible investigation.
- 15.3 I did receive a letter from the Chief of the Airforce, Lt Gen Msimang, dated 9 May 2013. Attached hereto as annexure "CA2" a copy of the letter. Also attached to this letter was questions that were posed which I received on 09 May 2013 and which I answered through my attorney on 10 May 2013.

16. Maj T Ntishisi:

- 16.1 I confirm the telephone conversation with the then WO Ntishisi. I however deny that I tried to influence WO Ntishisi and he admits to that.
- 16.2 I informed WO Ntishisi exactly what is recorded in the telephone conversation. For me it was more important to inform him that, if DIRCO gives authorisation, Waterkloof Airforce Base may accept Ministers, as

it happened on several previous occasions whilst I worked at Waterkloof Airforce Base.

17. Mr WM Matjila:

I agree with Mr. Matjila that this was a private visit. There are three types of visits namely official state visits, working visits and private visits.

18.Lt Gen DM Mgwebi:

- 18.1 (Page 45, line 8) The Officer Commanding Airforce Base Waterkloof does not get involved with the clearance at all. Once the clearance is authorized by Air Force Command Post (AFCP) (Level 3), the clearance is distributed to all the Government Departments as well as Airforce Base Waterkloof (Level 4) Command Post.
- 18.2 The Command Post at Waterkloof then distribute the documents to all the relevant units in the base being movements (Level 5), tower, fire section, 504 squadrons (security), counter intelligence, etc.
- 18.3 The Base Command Post then prepares a flying program with all the flights for the day and this is then forwarded to the office of the Officer Commanding for his information. This is the first time the Officer Commanding is informed of the flight.
- 18.4 (Page 51, line 8) I did not change any furniture as alleged. I removed the chairs of the Department of Defence ("DOD") because the welcoming party brought in their own furniture. I did not want the furniture of the DOD to get mixed up with the furniture that was brought in. The movement of the chairs only happened in the area adjacent to the VIP lounge, nothing was changed in the VIP lounge.



- 18.5 (Page 51, line 18) There was a cultural group that performed at the lounge. This was requested by Mr. Koloane. The vehicles that brought in the cultural group and that transported the passengers from the Base came through the security gates. The security gates is manned by 504 security squadrons. I did not interfere with the security gates at all. The security squadrons has their own procedures.
- 18.6 (Page 51, line 18) I did request the passengers that arrived not to take any photos but this was unfortunately disregarded.
- 18.7 (Page 52, line 9) The Base Command Post forwarded a copy of the overflight clearance to 504 security squadrons as well as the counter intelligence section. These two sections have their own procedures and it is their responsibility to be present with the arrival and control of all security issues.
- 18.8 (Page 52, line 25) There were clearances for all these aircrafts. I do not understand who did not know what was happening.
- 18.9 (Page 64, line 14) This is the responsibility of 504 security squadrons.
- 18.10 (Page 70, line 7) There was no policy or guidelines in 2013 at Airforce Base Waterkloof pertaining to the rolling out of the red carpet. This was confirmed with the Regimental Sergeant Major.
- 18.11 (Page 70, line 20) I was not informed the names of the Ministers. Normally we are informed beforehand of the names of the VIP's but in this instance no one informed us of the names of the VIP's and therefore I was not able to arrange for a meet and greet.

19. Lt Gen ZF Msimang:

No.

- 19.1 (Page 82, line 7) In 2013 when this aircraft landed I did not know about the SOP's existed and as I have stated previously Ministers have landed at Waterkloof Airforce Base.
- 19.2 (Page 90, line 22) Waterkloof Base is Level 4 and the movement units is Level 5. I have on several occasions indicated to the OCAFCP that Level 5 cannot do the planning of an operation and be the executor thereof. This is what happened with the movements section. I attended the protocol meetings (planning meeting) at DIRCO and I did the execution thereof at AFB Waterkloof.
- 19.3 (Page 100, line 11) I was interviewed at the Preliminary Investigation but I never received any feedback.
- 19.4 (Page 117, line 1) I have no knowledge about these recordings.

20. Ambassador VB Koloane

- 20.1 (Page 122, line 17) The Ambassador spoke to me after he spoke to the then WO Ntishisi.
- 20.2 (Page 152, line 14) A meeting took place on 22 April 2013 before the clearance was issued. I would have, during this meeting, informed those present that the arrival can continue provided a clearance is issued. I did receive a clearance for this flight on 23 April 2013.
- 20.3 (Page 154, line 12) I do not agree. At this instance a meeting did take place at AFB Waterkloof a day before I received the clearance.

CONVENING ORDER NUMBER 01/2013 DATED 3 MAY 2013

AFFIDAVIT

I, the undersigned,

LT COL CHRISTINE ANDERSON

do hereby make oath and state that:

- I am a major female Lieutenant Colonel in the employ of the South
 African National Defence Force ("SANDF") and more specifically within
 the South African Air Force ("SAAF") and I am residing at 918 Eight
 Avenue, Wonderboom South, Pretoria, Gauteng.
- 2 The facts contained herein fall within my personal knowledge and are both true and correct.
- During the afternoon of 7 May 2013 I was requested by the Chief of Joint Operations, SANDF, Lt Gen D Mgwebi, to attend a Board of Inquiry to take place on 8 May 2013. I was under the impression that the processes conducted at Waterkloof Air Force Base relating to the landing of the Gupta wedding passengers would be discussed.
- 4 I attended the Board of Inquiry on 8 May 2013. Present at the Board was Lt Gen D M Mgwebi as President and the members of the Board

- 9.1 During a Sunday evening between the end of March and beginning of April 2013 at about 2100B Ambassador Koloane, Chief Director State Protocol, Department International Relations and Cooperation (DIRCO) phoned me to enquire about the capacity of Waterkloof Air Force Base for the landing of an Airbus A330 relating to a cultural event. He also mentioned that there will be two ministers of board and that Number One has knowledge about the flight;
- 9.2 Number One is the President of the Republic of South Africa.

 We never refer to the President in telephone conversations by name for security reasons;
- 9.3 I said to him that it will be possible for the aircraft to land however, an overflight clearance (which is landing authority) from the Air Force Command Post is required for any aircraft to land at Waterkloof;
- 9.4 During this telephone conversation Mr Koloane informed me that he will send the coordinators for the arrival to ascertain the facilities and that he will start the process of obtaining overflight clearance from Air Force Command Base;
- 9.5 On 2 April 2013 a Mr Ashuc and two other gentlemen visited me at Air Force Base Waterkloof to do a site visit. I escorted them through the lounges. The gentlemen informed me that the party that will arrive will consist of approximately 150 to 200 people. I

were Maj Gen T Matlakeng, Maj Gen M Petani, Brig Gen E Z Mnisi and the Secretary was Col S Dlomo.

- At the outset of the Board I informed the members that I have obtained legal representation. The Board then requested from me whether I have any objection to answer questions and I agreed to do so on condition that whatever I stated at the Board should be typed and furnished to me and my attorney to either edit, change and/or delete as my attorney would advise.
- I furthermore confirm that I was not advised at all of Section 102 of the Defence Act and I was not advised as to my right to cross-examine any other witness to testify before the Board.
- During the week of 20 May 2013 I was once again contacted by the DoD and requested to attend the offices of Lt Gen Mgwebi to sign the statement that was agreed upon as mentioned herein above.
- On 24 May 2013 my legal representative and I met at the offices of Lt Gen Mgwebi. It was agreed at this meeting, where Brig Gen E Z Mnisi was also present, that I would furnish the Board with a statement in that the statement that was prepared by the Board was totally incorrect and contained factual averments that I had never made on 8 May 2013.
- 9 I therefore wish to state the following under oath pertaining to the convening order number 1/2013:

Je &

explained to them that the normal lounges facilities cannot accommodate 200 people. I was informed by the gentlemen that the idea was to provide breakfast and some entertainment to the people while the immigration process took place. I suggested the officer's mess as a viable alternative to accommodate the number of passengers. It was then agreed that the passengers could use, apart from the two lounges, the reception area of the Movements building. This area had previously also been used for certain functions. I was also informed that once the immigration process was finalised, that the passengers will be bussed to Sun City;

- 9.6 During this meeting I also informed the gentlemen that the ILS/VOR/NDB is currently out of service and that the implication can be that in the event of bad weather, the plane may be diverted to O R Thambo if the command post has cleared the flight;
- 9.7 On or about 17 April 2013 Mr Koloane phoned me and he informed me that he had returned from the President and that the President wanted to know "if everything is still on track for the flight". I informed him that we were awaiting the overflight clearance and once this was received, we would be able to finalise the movements of the passengers;

- On or about 19 April 2013 Mr Koloane once again phoned me and informed me that the passengers were no longer taking busses to Sun City but informed me that two fixed wing aircrafts and seven helicopters were to transport some of the passengers. I once again informed Mr Koloane the same process needs to be followed, clearance need to be obtained from Air Force Command Post for these aircraft. I then forwarded Brig Gen Lombard's office number to Mr Koloane as we were still waiting for the overfligth clearance for the first aircraft namely the Airbus A330. Brig Gen Lombard is the Officer Commanding at Air Force Command Post. I have proof of this sms;
- 9.9 Mr Koloane made an appointment to come and see me at
 Waterkloof on 22 April 2013. On this date Mr Koloane arrived
 with Mr Ashuc, two gentlemen and if I can recall, two ladies. I
 escorted them through the arrival and departure procedures:
- 9.10 During the afternoon of 22 April 2013 I went to my Officer Commanding, Brig Gen Madumane, and informed him about the aircraft as well as the additional aircraft which were to land at the base on 30 April 2013, once clearance were to be received. Brig Gen Madumane asked about the overflight clearance and whether the media will be allowed. I mentioned to Brig Gen Madumane that the overflight clearance was still in process and I did not have a response yet as to the media issue;



9.11 Clearance was received by me on 23 and 25 April 2013 respectively for all aircraft for this event...

ARRIVAL OF AIRBUS

- 10. The aircraft, that was cleared by Air Force Command Post and the other aircraft, to shuttle the passengers to Sun City, landed at Waterkloof during early morning 30 April 2013;
- 11. I followed the normal procedures and ensured that the responsible persons were present and me and my personnel took charge and supervised the buggage handling and loading.
- 12. Mr Koloane arrived late and apart from greeting him, we did not discuss the arrival any further;
- 13. I furthermore confirm that all the other state departments were notified. Some of the passengers flew to Sun City and others were escorted to Sun City. I do not have any knowledge as to who gave permission for these escorts.

DIRCO

- 14. Part of my duties is to communicate with DIRCO. DIRCO has three types of classifications for incoming aircraft and it is:
 - 14.1 Official state visits;
 - 14.2 Official working visits; and



- 14.3 Private visits.
- 15. This flight arrival was a private visit because the pre-arrival processes were the same as for all private category flights, i.e. no formal coordinating meeting requests from DIRCO. It does not mean that further additional authority is needed from DIRCO and the Command Post apart from the normal authority granted.

- 16. I attach hereto some of the authorisations that were forwarded to me to proceed with the take control over the movement of the passenger, buggage and flight at Waterkloof:
 - 16.1 Annexure A External Clearance Visiting Aircraft to SAAF Bases dated 9 April 2013 (received on 23 April 2013 by myself);
 - 16.2 Annexure B Permission for private helicopters and chartered flights (request);
 - 16.3 Annexure C Passenger list for 30 April 2013.






