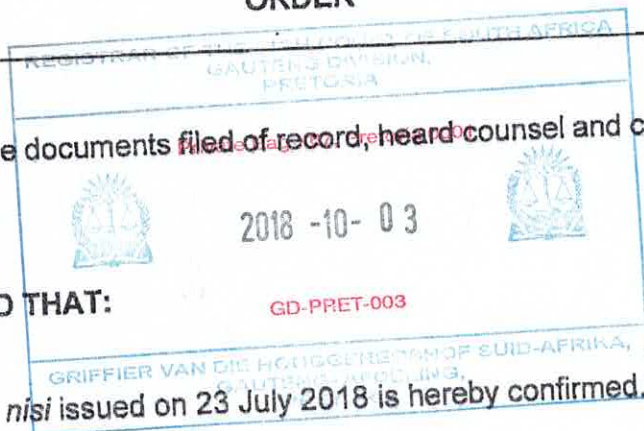

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

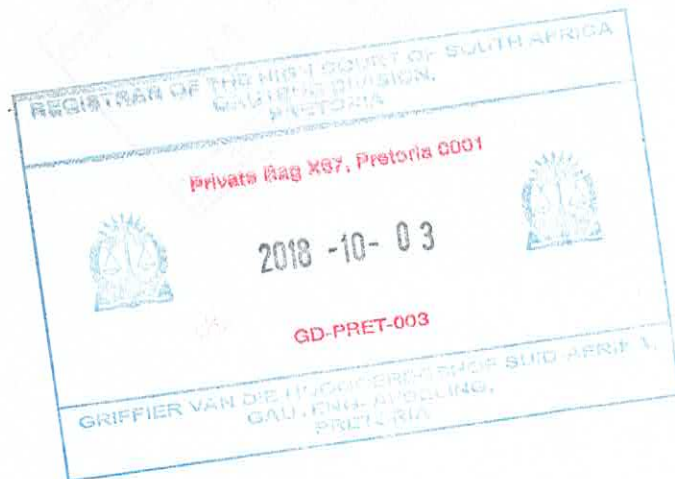
1. The rule *nisi* issued on 23 July 2018 is hereby confirmed.
2. The period of 180 days referred to in paragraph 4.3 of this Court's order dated 13 December 2017 in the matter of *President of the Republic of South Africa v the Office of the Public Protector and others* 2018 (2) SA 100 (GP) is extended for a further 24 (twenty-four) months calculated from 1 March 2018;
3. The President of the Republic of South Africa is ordered to take such steps as are necessary to give effect to the order referred to in paragraph 2 above, including the amendment of paragraph 5 of Proclamation 3 of 2018 published in *Government Gazette* no 41403 of 25 January 2018, to reflect the extended period;
4. There is no order as to costs.
